PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO: Board of Commissioners, San Juan County Fire Protection District No. 3

Comes now the following petitioner or petitioners, pursuant to RCW 52.04.031 et seq., and petitions the Board of Commissioners for annexation to San Juan County Fire Protection District No. 3. The property legally described below is within reasonable proximity to said Fire District, and is currently not a part of any fire protection district. This petition is signed by the owner or owners, according to the records of the county auditor, of not less than sixty (60) per cent of the area of land included in the annexation petition. The petitioner or petitioners are not assuming any pre-existing financial obligations of the district.

The proposed boundary expanded by this petition shall match the current San Juan County Public Hospital District No. 1 boundary, excepting the Town of Friday Harbor as defined in the State of Washington and the existing fire district boundary as defined in San Juan County, namely that the District annex Henry Island, Johns Island, and Stuart Island, as well as all other areas listed below.

Commencing at the meander corner common to sections 23 and 24, Township 35 North, Range 3 West, W. M., thence South 0.06 miles to a point in Griffin Bay; thence South 76 deg. 30' East 1.90 miles; thence North 30 deg. 20' East 0.80 miles; thence East 0.80 miles to the True Point of Beginning; thence North 0.82 miles; thence North 49 deg. 40' West 5.85 miles; thence North 30 deg. 47' West 3.25 miles; thence North 48 deg. 38' East 1.62 miles; thence North 32 deg. 45' West 7.05 miles, more or less, to the Northwest boundary of San Juan County; thence Southwesterly, Southeasterly, Southwesterly, and Northeasterly to a point in the Strait of Juan De Fuca which bears South of the true point of beginning; thence North 12.65 miles, more or less, through Middle Channel and San Juan Channel to the true point of beginning. The basis of bearing is true North, as derived from the Washington Coordinate System, North Zone.
